This marries a few themes together that were important to Fr David and themes that continue to be of resonance to us.

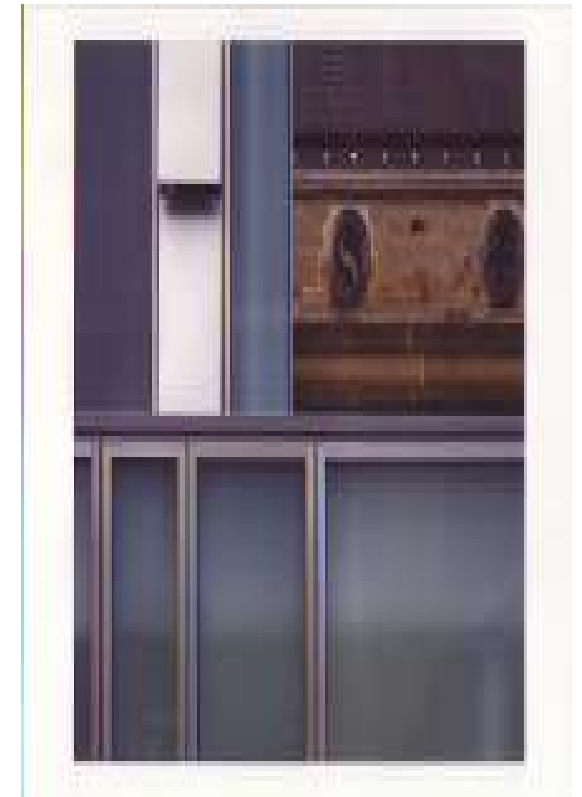
